ABU BAKR AL-SIDDIQ

He was firm, strong, and a just ruler. He was merciful to the Muslims and tough on the enemies of Islam. He conquered Jerusalem and defeated much of the Persian Empire. He kept all his governors in check and ensured total stability. Even Shaitan feared this man. He was devoted to ensuring the Muslims were well taken care of. **2nd Caliph**



UTHMAN IBN AFFAN

A master merchant who generously donated without hesitation, funding a significant portion of the Muslim army. Known for his modesty and gentleness towards Muslims, he loved reading the Quran and kept it close to his heart. He never shed Muslim blood unjustly, even when they did his. Despite this, he remained gentle with them. **3rd Caliph**.

ALI IBN ABI TALIB

SA`ID IBN ZAYD

His father, a monotheist, passed away before the coming of the Prophet Muhammad (SAW). As a commander and governor, his prayers were guaranteed, and companions were cautious not to upset him. He relinquished his governor position to engage in Jihad, as he loved fighting in the way of Allah (SWT). He was trustworthy, compassionate, and just.



ABU `UBAYDAH IBN AL-JARRAH

He was among the first ten to accept Islam and lived as an ascetic, shunning worldly luxuries. A humble battle commander, he always prioritized the Muslim army's needs over his own. Though not wealthy, he gave all he had to charity, keeping very little for himself.





Honored to lead the Prophet Muhammad (SAW) in prayer, he was also known for his extensive religious knowledge. His charitable contributions included hundreds of horses and camels.
